



DOMAIN: TIME ALLOCATION WORKLOAD DISTRIBUTION ON PAID AND UNPAID WORK AMONG WOMEN AND MEN IN AGRICULTURAL SECTOR

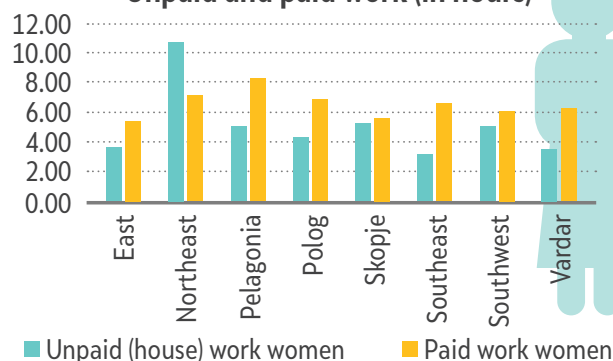
DEFINITIONS:

- **Activities included in paid work:** *On-farm work, Off-farm work, Products sale*
- **Activities included in unpaid work:** *Housework, Care for children and elderly members of the household*
- According the methodology, individuals are considered as disempowered in the domain "time allocation - workload" if work more than 10.5 hours per day in the previous 24 hours (Alkaire, 2013).

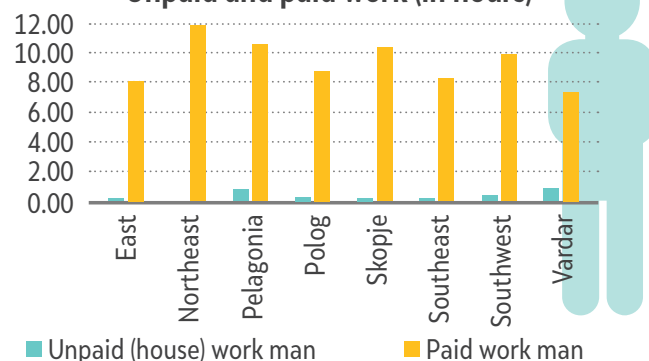
KEY FINDINGS:

- Women in agricultural sector have a larger workload than men.
- On average, women work 11.06 hours per day while men work 9.68 working hours per day.
- Men have mainly paid work, whereas almost half of women's work is unpaid (41,7% of the total workload belongs to unpaid work).
